The Kuala Lumpur Craft Complex is a 'One-Stop Craft Center', designed to combine the elements of marketing, education & acculturation. Here, visitors can purchase local handicraft, view heritage craft exhibitions, observe handicraft demonstrations and even participate in interactive craft activities, all within this one complex.

Royal Selangor

At the School of Hard Knocks, participants will learn how an enterprising teenager from China practised his craft, laying the foundation of what has become Royal Selangor. They will also be taken on an insightful tour of today's production processes in the factory.

Using just a few simple tools (hammer, wooden mould, scraper), participants will make a pewter dish personalised with their initials or whatever message that they wish to engrave onto the dish.

A day in the rainforest

An opportunity to explore the world's oldest tropical rainforest. Listen to the sounds of the rainforest and learn about hundreds of varieties of flora and fauna that can be found. Trek through primary and secondary tropical rainforest and swim in an open-air swimming pool – so do not forget to bring your swimming trunks! The tour begins with a visit to a batik factory and aborigine museum.

Note: Aborigine museum closes on Fridays and will be replaced with a visit to the Bat Caves.

Historical Malacca

Malacca, located 160 kilometres south of Kuala Lumpur, is the most important historical city in the country. Founded by Parameswara, a Hindu Prince from Palembang, Malacca was also ruled by the Portuguese, Dutch and English. The ruins and buildings of these conquerors can still be seen today. Among the places to visit are Porta de Santiago, St. Paul's Church, the Stadhuys Building, Christchurch, Cheng Hoon Temple (Oldest Chinese temple in Malaysia), Jonker Street, and China Hill.

Genting Highlands Tour

An hour's drive through the rolling hills and greenery, Genting Highlands is the highest international class highland resort at 2,000 metres above sea level and the only casino found in Malaysia, Singapore, or Thailand. There is the Amusement Centre, a 16-lane bowling alley, theatre and massage parlour. Enjoy a leisurely boat ride on the lake or take the kids on fun rides. For a bird's eye-view of the mountains, take a ride on a cable car.
